



2021 HEERWEG SPÄTBURGUNDER

Intense and warm, ripe dark cherry, plum, fleshy. Mouth-filling, fine, pure tannins underpinned by a juicy-spicy vein. Elegantly fine-grained with a menthol-like herbaceousness and rich structure.

VARIETY: Spätburgunder

VINTAGE: 2021

SOIL: Weathered limestone with rich layer of top soil

TASTE: bone dry, 0,1 g/L residual sugar

VINEYARD WORK:

Gentle pruning, manual breaking of the double shoots, application of horn manure and horn pebbles as well as compost tea

VINIFICATION:

Spontaneous fermentation with 100% whole cluster, ripening in small barrels (228L) for 18 months. No fining, no additions, no filtration, 100% nature
